When basement window wells flood, water leaks through the window into your basement. Proper grading and gutter care will help, but only by establishing a drain out of the well can you have the best chance of avoiding problems.

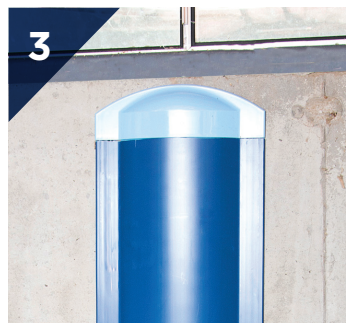

WellDuct establishes a drain from your window well to an interior perimeter drain such as our WaterGuard system.



1. A hole is drilled through the foundation wall below the window.
2. A strainer is installed on the outside of the hole.
3. The WellDuct is fastened and sealed to the wall, creating a vertical duct from your perimeter drainage system to the window well.
4. The WellDuct is connected to your perimeter drain system at the bottom, where the water can drain to your sump pump.
