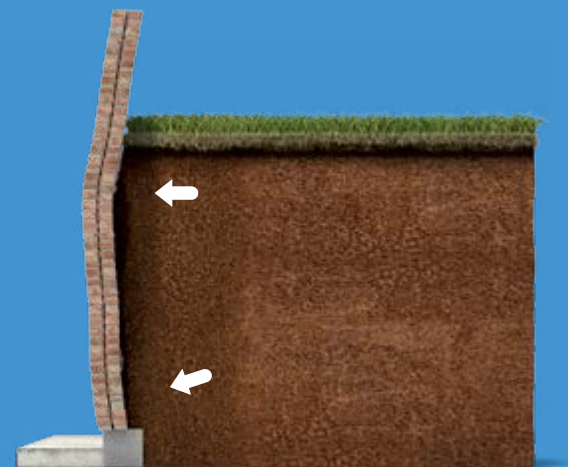

Even in cases where foundation walls have extreme damage, or when the walls are constructed with inadequate building materials such as stone, rubble, brick or clay tile, the ShotLock Restoration System offers you a long-lasting solution.

ShotLock utilizes a fiber-reinforced concrete material that is conveyed through a hose and pneumatically projected onto a wall surface. Due to the high force used to adhere it to the wall, the material undergoes a significant compaction process during installation that produces more than two times the strength of regular concrete, making it the ideal solution for deteriorating basement walls.

When ShotLock is installed in conjunction with GeoLock Wall Anchors, your foundation walls will be stable, solid, and completely restored.

Attach second anchor plate to anchor system on top of ShotLock

Spray second layer of ShotLock to fully embed the system

ShotLock wall surface is smoothed and finished
